6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to jurisdiction of courts
7 in cases concerning delinquent and dependent
8 minors."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.10.010(a) is repealed and re-enacted to
11 read:

12 (a) Proceedings relating to a minor under 18 years of
13 age residing or found in the state are governed by this
14 chapter when the minor

15 (1) violates a law of the state, or an ordinance
16 or regulation of a political subdivision of the state;

17 (2) by reason of being wayward or habitually dis-
18 obedient is uncontrolled by his parent, guardian or custodian;

19 (3) is habitually truant from school or home, or
20 habitually so conducts himself as to injure or endanger the
21 morals or health of himself or others;

22 (4) is abandoned by his parent, guardian or
23 custodian;

24 (5) lacks proper parental care by reason of the
25 faults, habit or neglect of his parent, guardian or custodian;

26 (6) associates with vagrant, vicious or immoral
27 people, or engages in an occupation or is in a situation
28 dangerous to life or limb or injurious to the health, morals,
29 or welfare of himself or others;

1 (7) is an orphan who has no relatives willing and
2 able to assume custody and care;

3 (8) has been released by his parent or parents, or
4 guardian, to the department for adoptive purposes; or

5 (9) is in need of special care or training not
6 otherwise provided.

7 * Sec. 2. AS 47.10.010(c) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

8 (c) In a controversy concerning custody of a minor,
9 the court may appoint a guardian of the person and property
10 of a minor and may order support from either or both parents.
11 Custody of a minor may be given to the Department of Health
12 and Welfare, and payment of support money to the department
13 may be ordered.

14 * Sec. 3. AS 47.10.060(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

15 (a) If the court finds at a hearing on a petition that
16 there is probable cause for believing that a minor is delin-
17 quent and finds that the minor is not amenable to treatment
18 under this chapter, it shall order the case closed. After
19 a case is closed under this subsection, the minor may be
20 prosecuted as if he were an adult.

21 * Sec. 4. AS 47.10.160(2) is amended to read:

22 (2) require and collect statistics on juvenile
23 offenses and offenders [HANDLED BY ALL DISTRICT MAGISTRATE
24 COURTS] in Alaska;

25 * Sec. 5. AS 47.10.290(1) is amended to read:

26 (1) "court" means the superior court [DISTRICT
27 MAGISTRATE COURTS] of the state;

28 * Sec. 6. AS 22.15.100 is amended by adding a new subsection
29 to read:

1 (5) to order a minor taken into custody pending
2 proceedings in the superior court arising under AS 47.10.010-
3 47.10.290.

4 * Sec. 7. AS 22.15.030(a)(6), 22.15.120(8), 47.10.060(b), and
5 47.10.060(o) are repealed.
