6 For an Act entitled: "An Act defining 'outside' service for
7 purposes of teacher retirement; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.25.220(8) is amended to read:

11 (8) "outside service" means service as a teacher
12 in a public school or an institution of higher learning
13 listed in the Annual Education Directory of Higher Education
14 published by the U. S. Department of Health, Education and
15 Welfare not under the supervision and control of the Depart-
16 ment of Education, [OR] the Territorial Board of Education,
17 the State Board of Education sitting in any capacity, the
18 school board of a borough school district, incorporated city
19 school district, incorporated school district, independent
20 school district, or the Board of Regents of the University
21 of Alaska;

22 * Sec. 2. This Act applies to a person employed as a full
23 time teacher in membership service between July 1, 1964 and
24 June 30, 1965, or any person employed as a full time teacher in
25 membership service any time subsequent to the effective date of
26 this Act.

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
28 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
