6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to allow designation of certain
7 school bus routes as hazardous and to
8 provide for the transportation of pupils
9 on these routes without restrictions based
10 on minimum distance."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 14.10.070 is amended by the addition of a new
13 subsection to read:

14 (c) The department shall periodically review routes
15 which public school pupils must travel to attend school, and
16 shall, by regulation, designate as hazardous those routes
17 which prevailing weather or traffic conditions make dangerous
18 to pupils not served by school bus. The department shall
19 provide for the transportation of pupils on routes designated
20 as hazardous in the manner provided in (a)(1) and (b) of
21 this section. Eligibility to receive school bus service on
22 routes designated as hazardous shall not be subject to
23 restrictions based on the minimum distance between establish-
24 ed schools and the residences of pupils.
