6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to allow designation of certain
7 school bus routes as dangerous and to pro-
8 vide for the transportation of pupils on
9 these routes without restrictions based on
10 minimum distance."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 14.10.070 is amended by adding a new subsec-
13 tion to read:

14 (c) The assembly or council of a borough or city which
15 is a school district, or the department, for areas not within
16 school districts, shall periodically review routes which
17 public school pupils must travel to attend school, and shall
18 by ordinance or regulation designate as dangerous those
19 routes which prevailing weather or traffic conditions make
20 dangerous to pupils not served by school bus. The designa-
21 tion may be limited in applicability to certain grades or
22 certain periods of the year or otherwise limited to meet
23 local circumstances. The assembly, council or the department,
24 as appropriate, shall provide for the transportation of
25 pupils on routes designated as dangerous. The additional
26 cost of such transportation in each district shall be shared
27 equally by the district and by the department. Eligibility
28 to receive school bus service on routes designated as
29 dangerous shall not be subject to restrictions based on the
