6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the expansion of courses  
7 and facilities of the University of Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.40.260 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.260. EXPANSION OF COURSES AND FACILITIES.

11 To expand educational and cultural opportunities in the  
12 state, to keep pace with the expansion of the state in other  
13 fields, and to provide educational facilities of particular  
14 interest to residents of the state, the Board of Regents is  
15 authorized to

16 (1) establish, operate and maintain a system of  
17 community colleges under secs. 560 - 640 of this chapter;

18 (2) supplement the community college program in  
19 major population centers having distinctive socio-economic  
20 patterns by establishing regional divisions of the University  
21 of Alaska at the junior college level;

22 (3) establish additional extension courses and  
23 such other expansion of accredited courses for students it  
24 considers advisable;

25 (4) provide independent facilities suitable for  
26 carrying out a university program;

27 (5) enter into cooperative, condominium, joint  
28 use, or co-ownership agreements for suitable facilities with  
29 private educational institutions or public bodies;
