For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to affidavit submitted  
7 when claiming a wolverine, wolf or coyote  
8 bounty; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.35.100 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.35.100. DUTIES OF IDENTIFYING OR CERTIFYING

12

OFFICER. Any officer of the Department of Fish and Game or

13

other person designated by the commissioner of fish and game,

14

upon receipt of an affidavit and claim together with pelt

15

and the ulna and radius bones of the left forearm or foreleg

16

attached in the natural state, shall examine the pelt. If

17

the affidavit states [HE BELIEVES] it is a wolverine, wolf

18

or coyote, legally taken within the state, he shall remove

19

the leg bones from the pelt, punch holes of not less than

20

one-half inch in diameter in the left ear of the pelt,

21

complete the identification certificate on the affidavit and

22

claim, and promptly forward the affidavit and claim to the

23

Department of Fish and Game, at Juneau, Alaska. The leg

24

bones shall be destroyed by the certifying officer and the

25

pelt returned to the claimant or to the person he designates.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
