6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the fish and game
7 officer's certificate of identification on
8 a claim for a wolverine, wolf or coyote
9 bounty; and providing for an effective
10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 16.35.070 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 16.35.070. OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE OF IDENTIFICATION.

14 A claim for payment of bounties shall contain a certificate
15 signed by an officer of the Department of Fish and Game or
16 other person designated by the commissioner of fish and game
17 to sign certificates, certifying that the officer or person
18 has personally examined the wolverine, wolf or coyote pelt;
19 has identified the pelt as a wolverine, wolf or coyote pelt;
20 that he believes the pelt was [LEGALLY] taken within the
21 state; and that he has personally removed the ulna and radius
22 bones of the left forearm or left foreleg from the pelt and
23 that he has punched holes in the left ear of the pelt, as
24 required by secs. 50 - 130 of this chapter.

26 (3) Affidavits of public officer.

Sec. 16.35.100. DUTIES OF IDENTIFYING OR CERTIFYING
OFFICER. Any officer of the Department of Fish and Game or
other person designated by the commissioner of fish and game,
upon receipt of an affidavit and claim together with the
pelt and the ulna and radius bones of the left forearm or
foreleg attached in the natural state, shall examine the
pelt. If he believes it is a wolverine, wolf or coyote
[, LEGALLY] taken within the state, he shall remove the leg
bones from the pelt, punch holes of not less than one-half
inch in diameter in the left ear of the pelt, complete the

1 identification certificate on the affidavit and claim, and
2 promptly forward the affidavit and claim to the Department
3 of Fish and Game, at Juneau, Alaska. The leg bones shall be
4 destroyed by the certifying officer and the pelt returned to
5 the claimant or to the person he designates.

6 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
7 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
