8 * Section 1. AS 22.05.020 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 22.05.020. COMPOSITION AND GENERAL POWERS. The
10 supreme court is a court of record and consists of three
11 justices including the chief justice. The supreme court is
12 vested with all power and authority necessary to carry into
13 complete execution all its judgments, decrees and determina-
14 tions in all matters within its jurisdiction, according to
15 the constitution, the laws of the state, and the common law.
16 It may prescribe by rule the fees to be charged by all courts
17 for judicial services except that no litigant may be required
18 to pay jury costs in any action before any court.
