6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' tenure rights;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.160 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.160. EXCLUSIONS. A teacher or administrator  
11 who has not completed employment [BEEN EMPLOYED] for at least  
12 two consecutive school years in a public school [THE SCHOOL  
13 SYSTEM] or who does not hold a standard [HOLDS A TEMPORARY]  
14 certificate is excluded from any rights under §§ 130 - 210 of  
15 this chapter. However, a teacher or administrator on a leave  
16 of absence shall not lose any rights under §§ 130 - 210 of  
17 this chapter if the leave of absence is

18 (1) approved by his school board or, if employed  
19 by the state, by the Department of Education and

20 (2) the teacher or administrator returns to  
21 employment in a public school not later than the beginning of  
22 the school year following termination of the period for which  
23 the leave of absence was granted.

24 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
25 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
