6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' tenure rights;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20.160 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.160. EXCLUSIONS. (a) A teacher or adminis-
11 trator who has not completed employment [BEEN EMPLOYED] for
12 at least two consecutive school years in a public school
13 district [THE SCHOOL SYSTEM] or who does not hold a standard
14 [HOLDS A TEMPORARY] certificate is excluded from any rights
15 under secs. 130 - 210 of this chapter. Tenure rights under
16 secs. 130 - 210 of this chapter are lost upon transfer from
17 one public school district to another or upon termination of
18 employment in a public school district. However, a teacher
19 or administrator on a leave of absence shall not lose any
20 rights under secs. 130 - 210 of this chapter if the leave of
21 absence is

22 (1) approved by his school board or, if employed
23 by the state, by the Department of Education and

24 (2) the teacher or administrator returns to employ-
25 ment in the public school district no later than the beginning
26 of the school year following termination of the period for
27 which the leave of absence was granted.

28 (b) For the purposes of this section, public school
29 district includes city school districts, borough school

districts, and the state operated school system.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
