6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' tenure rights;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.160 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.160. EXCLUSIONS. (a) A teacher or adminis-  
11 trator who has not completed employment [BEEN EMPLOYED] for  
12 at least two consecutive school years in the school system  
13 or who does not hold a standard [HOLDS A TEMPORARY] certifi-  
14 cate is excluded from any rights under secs. 130 - 210 of  
15 this chapter. Tenure rights under secs. 130 - 210 of this  
16 chapter are not lost upon transfer from one public school  
17 district to another nor upon termination of employment in a  
18 public school district. A teacher or administrator on a  
19 leave of absence shall not lose any rights under secs. 130 -  
20 210 of this chapter if the leave of absence is

21 (1) approved by his school board or, if employed  
22 by the state, by the Department of Education and

23 (2) the teacher or administrator returns to employ-  
24 ment in the public school district no later than the beginning  
25 of the school year following termination of the period for  
26 which the leave of absence was granted.

27 (b) For the purposes of this section, public school  
28 district includes incorporated, independent and city school  
29 districts, borough school districts, and the state operated

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
