ARTICLE 3. MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

Sec. 23.15.610. PARTICIPATION IN MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT

14

AND TRAINING ACT. In order to continue to participate in  
15 programs under the Manpower Development and Training Act of  
16 1962 (42 U.S.C. 2571-2620), the Departments of Labor and  
17 Education are each authorized to administer manpower develop-  
18 ment and training programs and to pay training allowances, to  
19 execute on behalf of the state agreements or contracts with  
20 the appropriate federal agencies containing such provisions  
21 as may be necessary or desirable to enable the state to  
22 participate in the programs, to expend all funds made availa-  
23 ble for the purpose of the programs by the state or local  
24 subdivisions of the state or by the federal government, to  
25 supervise the expenditure of the funds and the conduct of the  
26 programs by other public and private agencies of the state,  
27 and to make such reports and certificates as are called for,  
28 and otherwise to cooperate with the federal government and  
29 its departments and agencies in the administration of the
