6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state park and recrea-
7 tional areas."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.20 is amended by adding new sections to
10 art. 1 to read:

11 Sec. 41.20.044. VIOLATION OF REGULATIONS. A person
12 violating the regulations governing the use of state parks
13 and recreational areas may be required to leave the area by
14 any law enforcement officer, personnel under the control of
15 the Department of Natural Resources, or by other persons
16 specifically authorized to enforce the regulations of the
17 department.

18 Sec. 41.20.045. DAMAGE TO OR UNAUTHORIZED USE OF
19 PROPERTY. (a) It is unlawful for any person in state park
20 and recreational areas

21 (1) to damage, litter, or destroy any real or
22 personal property;

23 (2) to build a fire except in designated facilities
24 or places where fires are permitted;

25 (3) to operate a motor vehicle or a boat in areas
26 prohibited by the Department of Natural Resources, or to
27 operate any motor vehicle or boat in a careless or reckless
28 manner;

29 (4) to drive, park, or operate a motor vehicle

upon any of the premises without having paid the charges or use fee if any has been established and posted by the Department of Natural Resources.

(b) A person who violates any of the provisions of this section is punishable, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$1000.
