HOUSE BILL NO. 101

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of complimentary big game tags and the number of complimentary license tags which may be issued and the time for which they may be issued."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.05.335 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.335. COMPLIMENTARY LICENSES. The commissioner of revenue shall annually, at the request of the governor, provide him with not to exceed 50 [20] complimentary fishing and hunting licenses and appropriate big game tags which the governor may distribute to distinguished visitors to Alaska at his discretion for their use in any one season [IN ANY ONE 10-DAY PERIOD] during their visits to the state. The complimentary license for sport fishing or hunting or both shall be inscribed by the governor with the inclusive dates for its authorized use. The governor shall advise the Department of Fish and Game on any complimentary issuances, which information shall be available to the public.
