IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Board of Fish and Game to hold hearings to revoke, suspend or refuse issuance of guiding certificates and licenses under the Administrative Procedures Act, defining grounds for board action; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.05.405. REGULATING GUIDES. The Board of Fish and Game may, after holding a hearing pursuant to AS 44.62.330 - 630, revoke, suspend for a period not to exceed five years, or refuse issuance of a master guide certificate, or a guide or assistant guide license on the following grounds:

(1) Incompetency, dishonesty, or unethical conduct, which is in any way connected with guiding activities.

(2) Conviction of a violation of a federal or state sport fish, game or guide law or regulation, whether or not in connection with guiding activities.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
