5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to basketball scholarships
7 at the University of Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding new sections to
10 read:

11 ARTICLE 8. BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIPS

12 Sec. 14.40.710. PERSONS ENTITLED TO SCHOLARSHIPS. Any
13 person who has graduated from high school with a minimum of
14 a "C" average is eligible for a basketball scholarship en-
15 titling him to waiver of tuition and free room and board
16 at the University of Alaska until graduation.

17 Sec. 14.40.720. SELECTION AND DIVISIBILITY. The head
18 basketball coach at the University of Alaska may choose five
19 eligible persons each year whom he considers entitled to a
20 basketball scholarship. However, the head coach may divide
21 the benefits of any one scholarship for distribution as
22 separate scholarships.

23 Sec. 14.40.730. FORFEITURE OF SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS.
24 Failure to do passing work in more than one subject during
25 a semester, withdrawal or expulsion from the university,
26 quitting or being dropped from the basketball team, consti-
27 tutes a forfeiture of the scholarship.
