3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the boundaries of the
7 *See SLA 1964* City of Seward; and providing for an
8 *ch. 109* effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. PURPOSE. As a result of the emergency legislation
11 passed last session approximately 6,400 acres of land were annexed
12 to the City of Seward. It is now apparant that the amount of land
13 annexed is too vast for the City to provide road maintenance,
14 fire protection, sewer lines, water and other related services.
15 Since the people living in a large section of the area annexed must
16 pay city taxes even though it will be many years before the City of
17 Seward can provide them with any of these services, this Act change
18 the corporate limits of the City of Seward by reducing its North
19 and East land boundaries.

20 * Sec. 2. NORTH AND EAST LAND BOUNDARIES. The North and East
21 land boundary of the City of Seward, Alaska are described as
22 follows:

23 Beginning at the point at which the North limit of the
24 Resurrection River crosses the west section line of Section
25 22 Township 1 North Range 1 West Seward Meridian, thence in
26 a southerly and easterly direction along the North limit of
27 the Resurrection River to the point where it empties into
28 Resurrection Bay within Section 1 Township 1 South Range 1
29 West Seward Meridian, thence meandering the shore of Resurrec-

1 tion Bay in a southerly and easterly direction along the
2 line of mean high tide to the point where it intersects the
3 present limit of the Seward townsite.

4 * Sec. 3. DEFINITION. In sec. 2 of this Act, "North limit of
5 the Resurrection River" means the North limit of the river as
6 shown on the Seward A-7 Quadrangle (1951) 1:63,360 Series (Topo-
7 graphic) printed by the United States Geological Survey.

8 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
9 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
