6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment of non-
7 citizens by the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.05.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.05.010. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS
11 PROHIBITED. (a) It is unlawful for the state or a municipi-
12 pality in the state to employ as an officer a person who is
13 not a citizen of the United States.

14 (b) However, the Department of Health and Welfare may
15 employ doctors, dentists, public health nurses, and techni-
16 cians, and the Department of Fish and Game may employ
17 biologists or other technicians if they have filed their
18 declaration of intention to become a United States citizen
19 and take the oath prescribed in sec. 130 of this chapter.

20 (c) This section does not apply to teachers, librari-
21 ans, or other professional persons employed on an emergency
22 basis or temporarily employed or retained under a foreign ex-
23 change program.
