IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment of non-citizens by the state."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS ~~39.05.010~~ is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 39.05.010. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS

PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for the state or a municipality in the state to employ a person who is not a citizen of the United States if there is a citizen of the United States possessing equal ability, training and competence available. The determination of availability, ability, training and competence shall be made by the governing body of the municipality involved or the director of personnel, Department of Administration.
