6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of
7 dentists; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.36.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 08.36.220. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY.

12 The board shall license an applicant without examination if
13 the applicant

14 (1) meets the requirements of sec. 110 of this
15 chapter;

16 (2) has a license to practice dentistry in a state,
17 territory, district or possession of the United States or a
18 province of Canada which recognizes a license from this
19 state and issues reciprocal licenses;

20 (3) has a certificate from the board of dental
21 examiners where he is licensed stating that he is qualified
22 to practice dentistry there and that the license was issued
23 after a through examination qualifying the applicant.

25 * Sec. 3. AS 08.36.280 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

26 Sec. 08.36.280. TEMPORARY PERMIT. (a) An applicant
27 who is not licensed to practice dentistry in Alaska shall
28 be issued a temporary permit by the board to practice in a
29 place which does not have regular dental services for the

general public living there if the applicant meets the requirements of sec. 110 of this chapter and has not previously failed the examination given by the board.

(b) A temporary permit shall be valid until the results of the first examination given more than 30 days after issuance of the temporary permit are made available.

(c) Each permit shall state the name and address of the permittee and the place where and the period of time during which the permit is valid.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
