HOUSE BILL NO. 133

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the vote required for election to the office of borough chairman or member of the assembly."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 07.30.090 is amended to read:

Sec. 07.30.090. MAJORITY ELECTION [ELECTIONS]. The assembly shall [MAY] by ordinance, require a majority vote for election of the chairman and assembly. When a candidate has not received a majority vote in the initial balloting, a runoff election shall be held to obtain a majority vote for the office. The runoff shall be between the two candidates receiving the highest vote in the initial balloting for the office. [A RUNOFF ELECTION OR OTHER MEANS OF OBTAINING A MAJORITY MAY BE USED].
