6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to offenses against civil  
7 rights."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.60 is amended by adding new sections to  
10 read:

11 Sec. 11.60.280. CONSPIRACY AGAINST RIGHTS OF PERSONS.

12 A person who conspires to injure, oppress, threaten, or  
13 intimidate another person because that person seeks to  
14 exercise or enjoy, or has exercised or enjoyed, a right,  
15 privilege or immunity granted by the constitution or the  
16 laws of this state is guilty of a felony and upon conviction  
17 is punishable by imprisonment for not more than ten years,  
18 or by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or both.

19 Sec. 11.60.290. DEPRIVATION OF RIGHTS UNDER COLOR OF  
20 LAW. A person who, under color of any law, ordinance or  
21 regulation of this state or its political subdivisions, wil-  
22 fully deprives another person of a right, privilege or  
23 immunity granted by the constitution or the laws of this  
24 state, or who subjects another person to different punish-  
25 ments, pains or penalties because of that person's race,  
26 color, creed or national origin, is guilty of a misdemeanor  
27 and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not  
28 more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000,  
29 or both.
