6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to allow university students in
7 Alaska to vote in state and national elec-
8 tions."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.05.020(4) is amended to read:

11 (4) A person does not gain or lose a residence
12 solely by reason of his presence or absence while employed
13 in the service of the United States or of this state, [OR
14 WHILE A STUDENT OF AN INSTITUTION OF LEARNING,] or while
15 kept in an institution or asylum at public expense, or while
16 confined in a public prison or while residing upon an Indian
17 or military reservation.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 15.05.020(7) is amended to read:

19 (7) A person does not gain a residence in a
20 place to which he comes for temporary purposes only except
21 as provided in (10) of this section.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 15.05.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph
23 to read:

24 (10) A person who is enrolled as a full-time
25 student in a recognized college or university in the state,
26 and who was enrolled as a full-time student in a recognized
27 college or university in the state for at least the equiva-
28 lent of two semesters during the 12 months immediately pre-
29 ceding the election in which the person desires to vote, is

a resident for the purpose of determining eligibility to
vote; however, this shall not be construed as a determina-
