6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to weight fees for common
7 carriers, contract carriers and private
8 carriers; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 42.10.240(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) In addition to all other fees to be paid by him
13 every common carrier, contract carrier, and private carrier,
14 including those operating vehicles not otherwise registered
15 or licensed by the state, shall pay each year for each
16 motor vehicle, including a motor vehicle pulling a trailer
17 or semi-trailer, a trailer, semi-trailer, wrecker, tow car,
18 hearse, ambulance, truck or truck tractor owned or operated
19 by him on the public highways of the state, based upon the
20 actual maximum gross unladen weight as set by the carrier in
21 his application for his regular license plates, or in the
22 case of vehicles not otherwise licensed, as established by
23 the manufacturer's advertised weight, the following fees:

24 5,001 pounds to [LESS THAN] 12,000 pounds \$25

25 Over 12,000 pounds to [AND OVER BUT LESS

26 THAN] 18,000 pounds 40

27 Over 18,000 pounds 50

28 * Sec. 2. AS 42.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:
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Sec. 42.15.055. ~~WEIGHT FEES.~~ (a) Every common carrier by bus shall pay each year for each motor bus owned or operated by him, on the public highways of the state, based upon the maximum gross unladen weight as set by the carrier in his application for his regular license plates, the following fees:

5,001 pounds to 12,000 pounds	\$25
over 12,000 pounds to 18,000 pounds	40
over 18,000 pounds	50

Provided, however, that the weight fee for a motor bus with a seating capacity exceeding 20 used exclusively to transport tourists shall be 50% of that listed in the fee schedule.

(b) Buses used exclusively for transportation of children to and from school shall be exempt from weight fees designated in this section.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on February 15, 1966.
