6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to weight fees for common
7 carriers and contract carriers; and pro-
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.10.240(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) In addition to all other fees to be paid by him
12 every common carrier and [,] contract carrier, [AND PRIVATE
13 CARRIER,] including those operating vehicles not otherwise
14 registered or licensed by the state, shall pay each year for
15 each motor vehicle, including a motor vehicle pulling a
16 trailer or semi-trailer, a trailer, semi-trailer, wrecker,
17 tow car, hearse, ambulance, truck or truck tractor owned or
18 operated by him on the public highways of the state, based
19 upon the actual maximum gross unladen weight as set by the
20 carrier in his application for his regular license plates, or
21 in the case of vehicles not otherwise licensed, as established
22 by the manufacturer's advertised weight, the following fees:

23 5,001 pounds to [LESS THAN] 12,000 pounds \$25

24 12,001 [12,000] pounds to [AND OVER BUT LESS

25 THAN] 18,000 pounds 40

26 over 18,000 pounds . 50

27 * Sec. 2. AS 42.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

28 Sec. 42.15.055. WEIGHT FEES. (a) Every common carrier

29 by bus shall pay each year for each motor bus owned or

1 operated by him, on the public highways of the state, based
2 upon the maximum gross unladen weight as set by the carrier
3 in his application for his regular license plates, the
4 following fees:

5	5,001 pounds to 12,000 pounds	\$25
6	12,001 pounds to 18,000 pounds	40
7	over 18,000 pounds	50

8 Provided, however, that the weight fee for a motor bus with
9 a seating capacity exceeding 20 used exclusively to transport
10 tourists shall be 50 per cent of that listed in the fee
11 schedule.

12 (b) Buses used exclusively for transportation of
13 children to and from school shall be exempt from weight fees
14 designated in this section.

15 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on February 15, 1966.
