10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 22.15.010 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 22.15.010. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF
13 THE STATE OF ALASKA [MAGISTRATE COURTS]. There is established
14 a district court of the State of Alaska [MAGISTRATE COURT]
15 for each of the four judicial districts of the superior
16 court of this state.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 22.15.020 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 22.15.020. NUMBER OF DISTRICT JUDGES [MAGISTRATES].

19 (a) Except as hereinafter provided, each district court of
20 the State of Alaska [MAGISTRATE COURT] shall have the number
21 of district judges [MAGISTRATES] set out below opposite the
22 name of the judicial district over which the court has juris-
23 diction:

- 24 First Judicial District 3
- 25 Second Judicial District 1
- 26 Third Judicial District 4
- 27 Fourth Judicial District 2

28 (b) Except as hereinafter provided, each district
29 court of the State of Alaska [MAGISTRATE COURT] shall have

the number of [DEPUTY] magistrates set out below opposite the name of the judicial district over which the court has jurisdiction:

(c) The number of district judges or [DEPUTY] magistrates within each judicial district may be increased or decreased by rule of the supreme court.

* Sec. 3. Wherever the title district magistrate court appears in the law of this state, it shall be read as district court of the State of Alaska. Wherever the title district magistrate appears in the law of this state, it shall be read as district judge and wherever the title deputy magistrate appears in the law of this state, it shall be read as magistrate.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1966.
