For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to permanent identifica-
7 tion of historic vehicles."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.040 is amended by adding a new paragraph
10 to read:

10

(4) a vehicle for which permanent identification
12 plates and an identification certificate have been issued
13 under sec. 125 of this chapter, when the vehicle is being
14 driven or moved upon a highway for the primary purpose of
15 historical exhibition or for a similar purpose.

* Sec. 2. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17

Sec. 28.10.125. IDENTIFICATION OF HISTORIC VEHICLES.

18

(a) The department shall issue two permanent identification
19 plates and an identification certificate, to the owner of a
20 historic vehicle upon application by the owner under regula-
21 tions the commissioner of revenue shall adopt.

22

(b) The owner shall attach one of the identification
23 plates to the front of the vehicle and one to the rear.

24

(c) The identification plates are

25

(1) issued in a separate numerical series begin-
26 ning with "Historic Vehicle No. 1";

27

(2) of a distinguishing color;

28

(3) bear no date;

29

(4) permanent and remain with the vehicle upon

1 sale or transfer of the vehicle.

2 (d) The department shall charge the owner a fee of \$10
3 for the issuance of the identification plates and certifi-
4 cate.

5 (e) The identification certificate contains the name
6 and address of the owner of the vehicle, and shall be kept
7 either on the steering column, the window visor, or some
8 other prominent place in the vehicle.

9 (f) Upon transfer or sale of the vehicle the owner
10 shall return the identification certificate to the department.
11 The department shall issue a new certificate in the name of
12 the transferee or purchaser upon payment by the transferee
13 or purchaser of a \$2 transfer fee.

14 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.650 is amended by adding a paragraph to
15 read:

16 (20) "historic vehicle" means a motor vehicle
17 manufactured before the year 1933 which is driven or moved
18 upon a highway for the primary purpose of historical exhibi-
19 tion or for a similar purpose.

20 * Sec. 4. NUMBERING OF PLATES. Historic vehicle identifica-
21 tion plates are to be numbered starting with "1". The plate bear-
22 ing the number "1" shall be sent by the commissioner to the
23 University of Alaska for mounting on Alaska's first automobile,
24 which is now in the museum of that institution.
