6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bonding requirements for  
7 obtaining a beverage dispensary license."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.040(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The holder of a beverage dispensary license may  
11 sell for cash or serve on the premises beer, wine and hard  
12 liquors for consumption on the premises only. The beverage  
13 dispensary license fee is \$500 in all towns, villages,  
14 settlements, and places having a population not exceeding  
15 1,500 persons and \$1,000 in all towns, villages and in-  
16 corporated cities having a population in excess of 1,500  
17 persons. The population shall be determined at the time of  
18 filing the application. [EACH APPLICANT FOR A BEVERAGE  
19 DISPENSARY LICENSE SHALL FILE WITH THE APPLICATION A CASH  
20 BOND OR A SURETY BOND EXECUTED BY A SURETY COMPANY APPROVED  
21 BY THE BOARD. THE CONDITION OF THE BOND OR UNDERTAKING SHALL  
22 BE THAT THE APPLICANT OR APPLICANTS ARE THE SOLE OWNERS OF  
23 THE BUSINESS TO BE LICENSED, AND THAT NO OTHER PERSON IS  
24 FINANCIALLY INTERESTED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, AND THAT THE  
25 APPLICANT OR APPLICANTS WILL CONDUCT THE BUSINESS IN ACCORD-  
26 ANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE LAWS PERTAINING TO INTOXICATING  
27 LIQUOR IN THE STATE. THE BOND SHALL BE IN THE PENAL SUM OF  
28 \$2,500. UPON REVOCATION OF THE LICENSE, THE BOND MAY BE FOR-  
29 FEITED AND THE AMOUNT DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF
