6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the prevention of mental
7 retardation resulting from the disease
8 phenylketonuria."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.15 is amended by adding new sections to
11 read:

12 ARTICLE 6. DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION

13 Sec. 18.15.220. INFORMATION ON PHENYLKETONURIA. (a)

14 The department shall institute and execute an intensive
15 educational program among physicians, hospitals, public health
16 facilities and the public concerning the disease phenylketonu-
17 ria.

18 (b) The program shall include information about the
19 nature of the disease and the examinations needed for its
20 detection in order that measures may be taken to prevent the
21 mental retardation which results from phenylketonuria.

22 Sec. 18.15.230. REPORT OF TEST RESULTS. Each physician
23 and hospital shall report to the department the results of
24 tests made for phenylketonuria on forms provided by the
25 department.
