6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the payment of pre-  
7 vailing wages to state employees employed  
8 on temporary force-account projects; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to  
12 read:

13 Sec. 39.27.020. FORCE ACCOUNT WAGES. (a) Neither sec.  
14 10 of this chapter nor AS 39.25.150(2) applies to mechanics,  
15 laborers, or surveyors on temporary force-account projects.

16 (b) A person working on a temporary force-account  
17 project as a mechanic, laborer, or surveyor shall be paid  
18 the hourly wage prevailing for work similar to the work he  
19 is doing in the area in which he is working.

20 (c) The person making the payment under (b) of this  
21 section shall determine the prevailing hourly wage by refer-  
22 ring to the list of prevailing hourly wages published and  
23 distributed by the commissioner of labor.

24 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1965.
