6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the powers and duties of
7 the local boundary commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.260(a)(4) is amended to read:

10 (4) develop [PROPOSED] standards and procedures
11 for the extension of services and ordinances of incorporated
12 cities into contiguous areas for limited purposes upon
13 majority approval of voters of these contiguous areas and
14 prepare transition schedules and prorated tax mill levies as
15 well as standards for participation by voters of these con-
16 tiguous areas in the affairs of the incorporated cities
17 furnishing services.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 44.19.260(b)(2) is amended to read:

19 (2) present to the legislature during the first
20 10 days of a regular session proposed local government
21 boundary changes, including gradual extension of services of
22 incorporated cities into contiguous areas upon majority
23 approval of voters of these contiguous areas and transition
24 schedules providing for total assimilation of the contiguous
25 area and its full participation in the affairs of the incor-
26 porated city within a period not to exceed five years.
