6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the enforcement of con-  
7 tracts or bargaining agreements of labor  
8 organizations."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.40.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 23.40.020. ENFORCEMENT OF CONTRACTS (a) After  
12 July 1, 1966, a contract or bargaining agreement between an  
13 employer and a labor organization may not be enforced unless

14 (1) a labor organization having 110 or more  
15 members in good standing who reside or work in the state has  
16 one or more chartered local units in the state;

17 (2) a labor organization not subject to (1) of  
18 this section and which has no local unit in the state has  
19 registered with the department and complied with all regula-  
20 tions made by it; or

21 (3) a labor organization which has entered into a  
22 contract or bargaining agreement which is not to be executed  
23 by one or more of the labor organization's local units in  
24 the state has registered with the department and complied  
25 with all regulations made by it.

26 (b) Any national or international labor organization  
27 which violates (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemean-  
28 or and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not less  
29 than \$1,000 for each offense.

\* Sec. 2. On or before January 1, 1966, the Department of Labor shall conduct a secret ballot election for resident Alaskan members of a labor organization subject to sec. 1 of this chapter. The department shall adopt regulations specifying the conduct of the election and may require labor organizations to submit necessary membership lists and membership addresses. If a majority of the resident Alaskan members voting at such election reject local autonomy, the provisions of sec. 1 of this chapter shall not apply. If a majority of the resident Alaskan members voting at such election favors local autonomy, the provisions of sec. 1 of this chapter shall apply.
