6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the enforcement of con-  
7 tracts or bargaining agreements of labor  
8 organizations."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.40.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 23.40.020. ENFORCEMENT OF CONTRACTS (a) After  
12 July 1, 1966, a contract or bargaining agreement between an  
13 employer and a labor organization may not be enforced unless

14 (1) a labor organization having 110 or more members  
15 in good standing who reside and work in the state shall have  
16 one local charter and one or more elective units within the  
17 state;

18 (2) a labor organization not subject to (1) of  
19 this section and which has no local unit in the state has  
20 registered with the department and complied with all regula-  
21 tions made by it; or

22 (3) a labor organization which has entered into a  
23 contract or bargaining agreement which is not to be executed  
24 by one or more of the labor organization's local units in  
25 the state has registered with the department and complied  
26 with all regulations made by it.

27 (b) Any national or international labor organization  
28 which violates (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemean-  
29 or and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not less

1           than \$1,000 for each offense.

2           \* Sec. 2. On or before January 1, 1966, the Department of  
3 Labor shall conduct a secret ballot election for resident Alaskan  
4 members of a labor organization subject to sec. 1 of this chapter.  
5 The department shall adopt regulations specifying the conduct of  
6 the election and may require labor organizations to submit neces-  
7 sary membership lists and membership addresses. If a majority of  
8 the resident Alaskan members voting at such election reject local  
9 autonomy, the provisions of sec. 1 of this chapter shall not  
10 apply. If a majority of the resident Alaskan members voting at  
11 such election favors local autonomy, the provisions of sec. 1 of  
12 this chapter shall apply.
