5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating for a study relative
7 to expanded ferry service in Alaska; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$15,000 is appropriated from the
11 general fund to the division of marine transportation, Department
12 of Public Works, to be used to accomplish a study and report on
13 the feasibility and cost of providing the equipment and appurten-
14 ances, and the service to accomplish the following:

15 (1) shuttle or connecting ferries to serve Ketchikan,
16 Metlakatla, and vicinity; to serve Berner's Bay, William Henry Bay,
17 and Skagway; to serve Cordova, Valdez, Tatitlek, Ellamar and
18 Whittier; and to serve Katmai, Iliamna Lake and the west side of
19 Cook Inlet, and the Aleutian Islands;

20 (2) an extension of service by the existing system to
21 Tolstoy at Thorne Bay on Prince of Wales Island;

22 (3) local service by a large ferry vessel connecting
23 Juneau, Petersburg, Chatham, Icy Straits, and the Sitka area;

24 (4) service by an open sea ferry between Juneau and
25 Seward; and

26 (5) any other possible intrastate service by marine
27 transportation.

28 * Sec. 2. The unused portion of this appropriation lapses
29 into the general fund on June 30, 1966.
