5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salary schedule for  
7 school teachers; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.220(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (a) The school board of each school district in the  
12 Southeastern Senate District shall pay a regularly qualified  
13 teacher employed by it a salary not less than that set out  
14 in this subsection.

15 (1) The base salary of a teacher with three years'  
16 training is \$4,750 for a teacher with no public school  
17 experience in the state. The base salary is augmented by  
18 \$150 for each year of public school experience in the state  
19 up to and including four years.

20 (2) The base salary for a teacher holding a  
21 bachelor's degree and having the requisite number of hours  
22 in education is \$5,750, and is increased to \$6,000 effective  
23 July 1, 1966. The base salary is augmented by the sum of  
24 .04 times the base for each year of public school experience  
25 in the state up to and including eight years.

26 (3) The base salary for a teacher holding a  
27 bachelor's degree plus 18 semester hours toward a master's  
28 degree and having the requisite number of hours in education  
29 is \$6,000, and is increased to \$6,250 effective July 1, 1966.

1 The base salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the  
2 base for each year of public school experience in the state  
3 up to and including 10 years.

4 (4) The base salary for a teacher having a  
5 master's degree and having the requisite number of hours in  
6 education is \$6,250 and is increased to \$6,500 effective  
7 July 1, 1966. The base salary is augmented by the sum of  
8 .04 times the base for each year of public school experience  
9 in the state up to and including 12 years.

10 (5) The base salary for a teacher holding a  
11 master's degree plus 18 semester hours toward a doctor's  
12 degree and having the requisite number of hours in education  
13 is \$6,500 and is increased to \$6,750 effective July 1, 1966.  
14 The base salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the  
15 base for each year of public school experience in the state  
16 up to and including 14 years.

17 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
