6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to labor disputes and the
7 obtaining of employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 ARTICLE 10. LABOR DISPUTES.

12 Sec. 23.10.425. STRIKES. (a) No person, firm, or
13 corporation not directly involved in a labor strike or lock-
14 out may recruit and bring into this state any person for
15 employment, or secure or offer to secure employment for any
16 person, when the purpose of recruiting, securing or offering
17 to secure employment is to take the place in employment of
18 employees in a business owned by a person, firm, or corpora-
19 tion involved in a labor strike or lockout.

20 (b) No labor union may bring into this state, persons
21 to act as pickets of a business owned by a person, firm, or
22 corporation where a labor strike or lockout exists.

23 (c) This section does not apply to activities and
24 services offered by or through the state Department of Labor.

25 (d) A person who violates (a) or (b) of this section is
26 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by
27 a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not
28 more than six months, or by both.
