6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of  
7 doctors of osteopathy under AS 08.64; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 08.64.205. QUALIFICATIONS FOR OSTEOPATH APPLI-  
13 CANTS. Each osteopath applicant shall meet the qualifica-  
14 tions prescribed in sec. 200(1), (2), (3) and (6) of this  
15 chapter and shall

16 (1) submit a certificate of graduation from a  
17 legally chartered school of osteopathy approved by the  
18 board;

19 (2) submit a certificate from a hospital approved  
20 by the American Osteopathic Association which certifies that  
21 he has faithfully completed and performed the duties of  
22 resident osteopathic physician for one year;

23 (3) take the examination required by sec. 210 of  
24 this chapter.

25 \* Sec. 2. The State Medical Board shall grant a license to  
26 practice medicine in this state to a person who applies for a  
27 license on or before January 1, 1966, if the person has actively  
28 engaged in the practice of osteopathy in the state for at least  
29 one year before January 1, 1965, and if the person meets all of

1 the requirements in AS 08.64.205 except that the person is not  
2 required to take the examination prescribed in AS 08.64.205(3).

3 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
4 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
