6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing additional require-
7 ments for the filing of articles of in-
8 corporation by certain professional
9 organizations; and providing for an effec-
10 tive date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 10.05 is amended by adding a new section to
13 read:

14 Sec. 10.05,004. PROFESSIONAL CORPORATIONS. To insure
15 adherence to established rules of professional conduct and
16 ethics and to limit the rendition of professional services
17 by corporations to properly qualified and skilled personnel,
18 the incorporators of a corporation organized under this
19 chapter for the practice or rendition of the professional
20 service of architecture, accounting, dentistry, engineering,
21 law or medicine shall file with the articles of incorporation
22 required to be filed under sec. 258 of this chapter, a
23 certificate or written statement, signed by the president,
24 vice president or secretary of the licensing board for that
25 profession, which states that

26 (1) the proposed articles of incorporation have
27 been reviewed by the board;

28 (2) the rules of the board regarding incorporation
29 for the rendition of that professional service have been

complied with;

(3) the board has not found the prospect of incorporation or the contents of the articles of incorporation to be contrary to established rules of professional ethics or conduct; and

(4) the board approves the articles for filing.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
