BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.20 is amended by adding a new section to
13 read:

Sec. 23.20.376. BASE PERIOD EXTENSION AND LIMITATION.

15

(a) If the department finds that during his base period any
16 individual has been incapable of work during the greater part
17 of his working time in any calendar quarter, the base period
18 shall be extended a calendar quarter subject to the limitation
19 set forth in (b) of this section. The extension of an in-
20 dividual's base period may not exceed four calendar quarters.

21

(b) The maximum benefits payable as a result of the use
22 of wages earned in a calendar quarter prior to the individual's
23 current base period as defined in sec. 520(2) of this chapter
24 shall be reduced by the amount of benefits paid previously
25 as a result of the use of wages in computing a previous bene-
26 fit determination.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
28 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
