HOUSE BILL NO. 291

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the accumulation of  
annual leave by state employees."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.20.240 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.240. ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE. The  
annual leave which is not used by an officer or employee  
accumulates for use in succeeding years until it totals not  
to exceed 60 days at the end of [THE LAST COMPLETE MONTHLY  
PAY PERIOD IN] a calendar year. When an officer or employee  
loses more than five days annual leave due to the press of  
agency business the agency head shall, on the request of the  
officer or employee, certify to the Department of Adminis-  
tration that the leave was lost due to the requirements of  
the agency and the officer or employee shall be paid on the  
basis of his regular salary for the days of annual leave  
lost but payment shall not be made for five days or less or  
for more than 15 days.
