6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of
7 motor scooter, motor bicycle, and motor-
8 cycle operators; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to
12 read:

13 Sec. 28.35.145. CERTAIN OPERATORS TO WEAR HELMETS. It
14 is unlawful for an operator of a motor scooter, motor bicycle,
15 or motorcycle to operate the vehicle without wearing a crash
16 helmet to protect him from injury.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 28.35.175. OPERATION OF MOTOR SCOOTERS, MOTOR
19 BICYCLES, AND MOTORCYCLES. It is unlawful for an operator
20 of a motor scooter, motor bicycle, or motorcycle, to allow
21 a passenger to ride on the vehicle with him unless the machine
22 is manufactured to accommodate a passenger and the operator
23 is 18 years of age.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
25 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
