6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of motor  
7 scooter, motor bicycle, and motorcycle  
8 operators; and providing for an effective  
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to  
12 read:

13 Sec. 28.35.145. CERTAIN OPERATORS TO WEAR HELMETS. It  
14 is unlawful for an operator of or passenger on a motor scooter,  
15 motor bicycle, or motorcycle to operate or ride the vehicle  
16 without wearing a crash helmet to protect him from injury.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 28.35.175. OPERATION OF MOTOR SCOOTERS, MOTOR  
19 BICYCLES, AND MOTORCYCLES. It is unlawful for an operator  
20 of a motor scooter, motor bicycle, or motorcycle, to allow  
21 a passenger to ride on the vehicle with him unless the machine  
22 is manufactured to accommodate a passenger and the operator  
23 has effective liability coverage for the protection of the  
24 passenger against bodily injury in the sum of not less than  
25 \$10,000 when the operator is riding on a public highway.
