HOUSE BILL NO. 298

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the littering of high-
ways."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 19 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 17. LITTERING OF HIGHWAYS.

Sec. 19.17.010. HIGHWAY LITTERING PROHIBITED. A per-
son who throws, drops or otherwise places litter, rubbish,
cans, bottles or other offensive or unsightly matter upon a
highway as defined in AS 19.05.130(8), or within 200 feet of
a highway, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is
punishable by imprisonment for not more than 60 days, or by
fine of not more than \$300, or by both.

Sec. 19.17.020. POSTING OF LAW. The commissioner of
highways shall place a sign near the state boundary at each
primary and secondary highway which informs the public of the
prohibition against, and penalty for, highway littering and
may place similar signs at other locations in the state when
considered necessary.
