6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the littering of high-
7 ways."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.20.590(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) No person may put or throw any kind of garbage,
11 rubbish, or material, or abandon animal viscera or other
12 discarded objects on a highway, highway right-of-way, or
13 public recreation facility. No person may put or throw any
14 kind of litter or trash from a highway or highway right-of-
15 way onto private property.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 19 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

17 Sec. 19.17.010. POSTING OF LAW. The commissioner of
18 highways shall place a sign near the state boundary at each
19 primary and secondary highway which informs the public of
20 the prohibition against, and penalty for, highway littering
21 and may place similar signs at other locations in the state
22 when considered necessary.
