5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale or distribution
7 of liquor in a licensed premises which is
8 also a first class restaurant."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(d) is amended to read:

11 (d) Presence of minors on premises. It is unlawful to
12 permit a person under the age of 21 years to enter licensed
13 premises unless the minor is accompanied by his parent,
14 guardian or spouse who has attained the age of 21 years.
15 However, if the licensed premises is also recognized as a
16 first class restaurant for public dining, a minor when
17 accompanied by a responsible person over 21 years of age
18 may enter the premises for purposes of dining. The Alcoholic
19 Beverage Control Board shall designate which premises are
20 first class restaurants for the purposes of this section and
21 promulgate regulations for their designation and the continu-
22 ation or withdrawal of the designation.
