6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons 19 or 20 years  
7 of age entering restaurants, which are also  
8 licensed to sell alcoholic beverages, for  
9 purpose of dining."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.020(d) is amended to read:

12 (d) Presence of minors on premises. It is unlawful to  
13 permit a person under the age of 21 years to enter licensed  
14 premises unless the minor is accompanied by his parent,  
15 guardian or spouse who has attained the age of 21 years.  
16 However, a person who is 19 or 20 years of age may enter  
17 licensed premises which are also recognized as a restaurant  
18 for the purpose of dining. A person under the age of 19  
19 years may enter licensed premises which are also recognized  
20 as a restaurant for the purpose of dining if accompanied by  
21 the parent or guardian of any other minor also present, or  
22 with any other adult with the consent or acquiescence of  
23 the minor's parent or guardian. The Alcoholic Beverage  
24 Control Board, with the approval of the city council if the  
25 premises are within the city or with the approval of the  
26 borough assembly if the premises are outside the city but  
27 within a borough, shall designate which premises are restau-  
28 rants for the purposes of this section. The Alcoholic  
29 Beverage Control Board shall promulgate regulations for the

1 designation of restaurants and the continuation or withdrawal  
2 of the designation. Any provision herein to the contrary  
3 notwithstanding, no establishment shall be designated as a  
4 restaurant for purposes of dining without the consent of the  
5 licensee.
