6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the making of public  
7 buildings and facilities accessible to, and  
8 usable by, the physically handicapped; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 35.10 is amended by adding a new section to  
12 read:

13 Sec. 35.10.015. ARCHITECTURAL BARRIER REGULATIONS. The  
14 Department of Public Works is responsible for preparing and  
15 promulgating regulations governing the construction of public  
16 buildings and facilities by or for the state and its political  
17 subdivisions to insure that the public buildings and facili-  
18 ties are accessible to, and usable by, the physically handi-  
19 capped. The regulations of the department shall conform as  
20 far as it is feasible to the publication entitled "American  
21 Standard Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities  
22 Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped" or  
23 any amendments thereto as approved by the American Standards  
24 Association, Incorporated, under the sponsorship of the  
25 National Society for Crippled Children and Adults and the  
26 President's Committee on Employment of the Physically  
27 Handicapped.

28 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1967.
