HOUSE BILL NO. 307

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the term of office of
the chairman of an organized borough."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.25.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 07.25.010. EXECUTIVE POWER. The executive power
of the organized borough is vested in the borough chairman
who is elected at large. He must be a qualified voter of the
organized borough. His term of office is the same as that of
the mayor in the largest first class city in the borough or
three years if there is no first class city in the borough.
The term of office begins on the same day as that of the
mayor in the largest first class city in the borough or on
the first Monday following his election if there is no first
class city in the borough. [THE ASSEMBLY MAY PROVIDE A
DIFFERENT TERM BY ORDINANCE.]
