6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the computation of term
7 of imprisonment; and providing for an effec-
8 tive date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 11.05.040 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 11.05.040. COMPUTATION OF TERM OF IMPRISONMENT.

12 When a person is sentenced to imprisonment [IN THE PENI-
13 TENTIARY], his term of confinement begins from the day of
14 his sentence. A person who is sentenced shall receive credit
15 toward service of his sentence for time spent in custody
16 pending trial or sentencing, or appeal, if that detention was
17 in connection with the offense for which sentence was im-
18 posed. The time during which the person is voluntarily
19 absent from the penitentiary, reformatory, jail, or from
20 the custody of an officer after his sentence, shall not be
21 estimated or counted as a part of the term for which he was
22 sentenced.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
24 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
