6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a standard time for the  
7 state; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 44 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 14. STANDARD TIME.

11 Sec. 44.14.010. STANDARD TIME. The standard time to be  
12 observed by the state and its political subdivisions is  
13 Pacific Standard Time as defined by the Congress of the United  
14 States except that from 1:00 a.m. on the last Sunday in April  
15 until 2:00 a.m. on the last Sunday in October the standard  
16 time to be observed by the state and its political subdivi-  
17 sions shall be one hour in advance of Pacific Standard Time.  
18 The official time provided for in this section governs all  
19 laws and regulations relating to the time of performance of  
20 any act by an officer or department of the state and its  
21 political subdivisions, the time that any right accrues or  
22 determines, the time that any act shall or shall not be per-  
23 formed by any persons subject to the jurisdiction of the  
24 state, and to all contracts or choses in action made or  
25 performed in the state.

26 \* Sec. 2. This Act shall become effective at 12:01 a.m.
